NOTICE TO COMPETITORS – NUMBER 1

Dear 2022 Star World's Competitors:

With the cooperation and assistance of the local Star Class Fleet Representative, Tomas Hornos, I am pleased to report that there is a <u>limited availability of appointments</u> to receive Bow Numbers Application on Saturday, 3 September 2022 ONLY. Competitors interested in doing so should contact Tomas Hornos at +1 (781) 771-7206 or <u>tomashornos88@gmail.com</u>.

Boats, once bow stickered, may remain afloat and only the items required for measurement need be presented at your **Reserved Measurement Arrival Time Slot** (Paddle, Tow Line, Personal Flotation Device, no more than two mainsails and two jibs).

Several of you were previously told by the Organizing Authority that you needed to present your boat on its trailer for measurement. This was to ensure a <u>dry bow</u> for Bow Number adhesion to guarantee an equitable race through necessary start line visibility. If you received such an individualize communication, this notice supersedes only the instruction that your boat must arrive by trailer and cannot arrive by water.

Please take special notice of the following:

Important Notes:

- a. No change in Measurement Time Slots.

 If your boat is already afloat, please bring your required items to measurement.
- b. No Star boats or trailers can be accommodated on the EYC grounds before Wednesday, 7 September 2022.
- c. Competitors who choose to be afloat early are 100% responsible for launching, mooring and dock space for their boats prior to Wednesday, 7 September 2022.
- d. Competitors remain responsible for delivering their trailers to the EYC no sooner than Wednesday, 7 September 2022.
